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Survey Terminology

The following terms are used throughout all surveys:

Board of Nursing: Jurisdiction's governmental agency responsible for the regulation of nursing practice. Includes any other terminology to refer to the regulatory authority (i.e., commission, examiners, registration, jurisdiction). When referring to Board of Nursing, the reference collectively includes Board Members, Executive Officer and Staff

Jurisdiction: Refers to state, territory or district where a Board of Nursing is located. May also be used to refer generally to the Board of Nursing in a particular jurisdiction

Board Staff: Staff of the Board of Nursing

Executive Officer: Person responsible for running the Board of Nursing. Includes any other terminology to refer to that authorized person (i.e., Executive Director)

Board Member: Member of the governing body of the Board of Nursing as outlined by statute

Practical Nurse or PN: Licensed practical or vocational nurse (LPN/LVN)


Assistive Personnel: Generic term to identify non-nursing health care personnel



Q2. Are there specific statutes or regulations that reference delegation for any of the following assistive personnel? (Check all that apply)





Q3. Does the Board of Nursing approve training programs for any of the following assistive personnel? (Check all that apply)



Q4. Is the Board of Nursing responsible for the initial competency evaluation of any of the following assistive personnel? (Check all that apply)











Q5. Does the Board of Nursing administer or outsource assistive personnel initial competency examinations? (Check all that apply)

Q8. Does the Board of Nursing maintain a registry of assistive personnel employed in home health care agencies?




Q9. Does the Board of Nursing have the authority to take disciplinary action on assistive personnel licenses?




